



# SCS2 Commanders Handset

## Hand Held Controller for 4 Sniper Teams

### Features

- Hand Held
- Powered from Standard Radio Battery
- Heartbeat Confirms Communications OK
- Controls Individual and Coordinated Fire
- Digital Wireless Communication
- Shows Status for Each Team
- Target Ident can be sent to Sniper
- Target Ident can be Received from Sniper Team
- Up to 20km Range
- Console Plugs in to Video Network for Integrated System

### Description

The **SCS2** is a hand held Commanders Controller for controlling up to 4 Sniper Teams over a secure wireless link. The teams use the SCST2 handset to receive and transmit status feedback to the Commander. Larger systems can be created by linking handsets together.

The **SCS2** features a tri colour status LED for each team, which shows 'On Line' 'Ready' and 'Stand By'. The Stand By command is sent when the Commander flips the cover off the Fire Button(s). A LED in the centre of the Fire button shows Green when the Sniper is on target and extinguishes when he is not on target. This is activated by a push button on the Snipers weapon and transmitted automatically from the Snipers handset.

Special tones are generated by the Snipers handset which feed directly in to a earpiece to indicate his status and received commands. Tones are not transmitted over the air, but are decoded from secure digital data sent from the Commander.

When the Fire button LED is green, the commander can issue a Fire command direct to a Sniper by pressing the Fire Button.

To co-ordinate the fire between multiple teams, the Commander simply selects 'Coordinated Fire' and flips up the Fire button covers of the Sniper Teams which he wants to fire simultaneously. When all the relevant Snipers indicate they are on target, the Fire command is automatically send to the teams.

Target numbers can be transmitted to each Sniper to define their own targets, or the Sniper can feed back to the Commander which target he is on. This is via a single digit numeric display on the Commanders and Snipers handsets.

The **SCS2** forms part of an integrated video control system. When the handset is plugged in to the SCS2 Video Case, the Video mesh network and the wireless command system are linked together as an integrated system. This enables the SCS2 to be used in a variety of operation roles with or without video cameras fitted to weapons or auxiliary cameras.
